Dear Parents or Guardians,

We are pleased to announce that Hartford Public Schools will be implementing a new option available to schools that participate in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. It is called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) beginning in school year 2018-2019, and will include CREC Montessori.

What does CEP mean for my student(s) who attend CREC Montessori? In a CEP school, all students receive a nutritious breakfast and lunch at no cost, regardless of family income. Meal applications will not be collected.

What if my child changes schools? If your child will no longer be enrolled at CREC Montessori, please contact the new district to determine whether or not it participates in CEP.

What if my child has money on account? If your child has monies on account they can be used for purchasing a la carte foods or a refund can be requested. If you wish a refund, please contact Gisele Cebollero, Accountant for the Food Service Department at GCebollero@hartfordschools.org, and include the following:

4. First and Last name that should appear on the reimbursement check
